KEY POINTS FROM GENERAL MEETING SUN. JULY 25th 2010

Meeting held at Australian Speedway Museum & Hall of Fame, Avalon

1. Committee and General Meetings will be held on a more regular basis as per the constitution
2. It was moved that the club increase General Committee Members from 2 to 6. To be ratified at the next AGM.
3. The Club will form subcommittees to assist with running events, fundraising etc.
All members encouraged to contact committee to assist in running events
1. Paul Wren presented with a gift in appreciation for all his hard work organising donations for club raffles.
2. 2 delegates to attend SCCA stewards conference. Peter Green & Gary Bowden to attend on our behalf.
3. Race dates will be sent to all members and posted on the website.
4. Tow money for national title discussed, no figures available at the time of meeting.
5. State wide series to be held with 8 races not 6. This will be sponsored by Parr Motorsports. More sponsors and help need to run this series. Volunteers to be called for via newsletter etc. Name of series to be discussed at next meeting.
6. Points will be included in the series for attendance.
7. Concerns over track conditions at Redline for the Vic Title were raised. The Committee will liaise closely with Redline to ensure best & safest track possible for title.
8. The Club will be investigating the cost and viability of the use of transponders.
9. Where possible the Committee will have available a representative or delegate at tracks to speak on behalf of the drivers.
10. Jye Saunders Reported on the National AWS meeting held at Tullamarine, 24/7/10
 - There is to be a national point score system with a chassis as a prize. Points can only be gathered in your own state. Dates to be advised
 - Registrations are not Transferable.

Clarification: Registration of cars, drivers are registering the number not the cars and procedures of this.

- a. Wingless Sprints chassis as a Sprint car chassis is considered to be a changeable component of the car. Due to this AWSR registers the number not the physical car therefore if the registration is not transferable when a car is sold.
 - b. The new owner must register the car in their name with their number.
- SCCA are not interested in V8 powered wingless sprints at this point.
 - Head protection bars can be bolt in or welded. Members to check latest rules.
 - New Battery Rules. Battery location Optional, No Clamps, No wet cell batteries allowed. It's the committees opinion that Victorian Owners do not mount battery under seat for safety reasons and remain forward of engine plate.
 - Numbering System.

Now that states are getting low on free numbers, once a state has registered 90 cars or more it is able to allocate numbers 100 to 200.

As the club grows to triple figures we will not be going to a prefix. We will use triple numbers

Before we attend a national or represented meeting in future a general meeting will be held to ensure the issues of all members are considered and presented on the clubs behalf.

2010 National Stewards & Technical Officers Seminar - Report

Meeting held Saturday 14th August 2010 at Holiday Inn Sydney.
Attended by Peter Green

Agenda was to cover action items from 2009 meeting, election of assistant stewards and technical stewards for championship, discuss changes to new rule book and safety

This report will focus on safety, and rules related to AWSR.

Please ensure this report is not used as fact and owners are to refer to the new 2011 SCCA rule book at all times.

Safety

- Underwear.
Nomex underwear is to be worn at all times under driving suit no matter what suit. Ensure underwear covers from Neck (Turtle Type only) to wrist to ankles. T shirts do not cut it. 3 layer suit undone does not cut it either.
- Seat Belts.
No 2 inch belts allowed
Mounted to separate bar to seat
- Owners and drivers are advised to obtain manufacturer specifications and supporting documentation when purchasing parts and components as there have been reports of some parts failing causing accidents. SCCA to attempt to obtain same.
- Apparel
Ensure all safety apparel is worn at all times, in good order, meets specifications and in date
- Head Height.
Ensure head height clearance is checked and correct.

Rules:

- New rule book still imprint at time of meeting and report
- Some rules missed last years print such as. Adjustable timing chain, after market flex plate allowed and harmonic balancer must stay standard
- Clarification requested of some rules.
- 2 x new rules missed in print and sent as addendums. Note: NASDAI to forward to all members
- Head Protection Bars.
Approved bolt in bars only or welded in bars
Note: It was discussed class would move towards bolt in only for ease of removal for when extracting an injured driver.
- Battery Mounts**
Location is optional, must be welded or bolted to chassis. No clamps, must be sealed, no wet cell type allowed.
It was voiced that the Victorian committee had concerns over safety when mounting battery rear of engine plate or under seat.

** It is the opinion of the NSDAI committee, that all cars built in Victoria have batteries mounted forward of engine plate.**

Report Continued

Other

- I raised scrutineering accreditation and it was discussed, however, there is no national program in place. It was left to the states to arrange their own program.
- Scrutineering hand book in draft for wingless sprints. Mark Gary looking for input from Victorian Scrutineers.
- Mark Garey pushing for the national body to supply an engine test kit for AWSR organisers in each state, starting with a kit to be shared between states (NSW & QLD) , (Vic & SA) etc.
- Peter Green NSDAI raised the implementation of a self scrutineering sheet for owners and drives to sign and be present with log book at each event
It was agreed it would be worth implementing but as a state only trial.
- New drivers to be issued a "P" license as per rule book.
- Draft education program for new drivers discussed
- Infringement notice booklets issued.
- When is a lap a lap.
- Registration of car is not transferable.
- Mark Garey discussed rev limit testing and how it should be done. Mark is also putting together an engine check list for major events. Rev limit checkers now used widely
- Recommended motors to be sealed after checking.
